

Reflecting on the success of two previous exhibitions, SESPN once again aligned the theme of bullying with art, resulting in an extraordinary display of community- led art and engagement from community, schools, and the broader art community. The art portrayed a unique story of resilience, hope, change and strength.

The Spotlighting Bullying exhibition aligns with the networks core values. Along with our partner the Rotary Club of Oakleigh Clayton Huntingdale, we remain committed to raising awareness and fostering hope in a future free from suicide.

Our sincere appreciation to Pratibha Madan for her outstanding curatorial expertise and unwavering professionalism, both of which were pivotal in the successful presentation of our third exhibition, featuring works by students and community members, along with an interactive artwork, Seeds of Change: Art for a Kinder World - a collective "Tree of Hope".

Planning for our 2026 Spotlighting Bullying art exhibition around World Suicide Prevention Day, in September, is underway. Thank you!



The **August Art Connect** Monthly Workshop featured a truly captivating session on 'Bead Jewellery Making', expertly guided by our multi-talented member artist, Jayashree Iyer.
